



LEAN BOOT CAMP

Train your team on the fundamentals of Lean manufacturing, including key principles, tools, and techniques you can apply to make an immediate impact.

Lean Boot Camp is an intensive, three-day course of classroom discussion and hands-on simulation which provides an enterprise view of Lean tools and principles. This course stresses not only Lean techniques, but also the culture and environment necessary to realize their potential—continuous improvement combined with respect for people.

Topics Covered Include:

Day 1: Foundation of Lean, Value Stream Mapping, 5S, Quality at the Source

Day 2: Teamwork, Training, Autonomous Maintenance, Quick Changeover

Day 3: Push vs. Pull, Problem Solving, Standardization, Implementation
